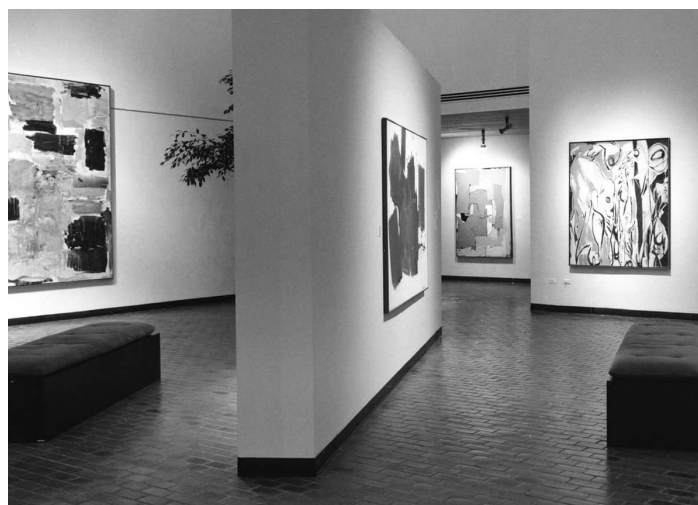


## Funded by Blaffer Art Museum
